Dalet-Ancient Symbol – Tent, Door

Some meanings – Door, pathway, enter

Dalet – conveys to us that kindness, giving of oneself to others and bringing them intimately near to oneself is the foundation of human life and is expressed by the words “You shall love your neighbor as yourself” Lev. 19:18.

The opposite of intimacy and nearness is isolation.

Isolation negates life and simultaneously interferes with man’s relationship with His creator.

One of the tricks of the enemy is to try to get believers isolated from other believers. Isolation is deadly spiritually, emotionally and physically.

We were created to need God in our lives, to need companionship via marriage and also the need for Community fellowship

A door is always an entrance into something, it allows you into a place and keeps you safe when inside.

It can also keep you from entering if locked and closed.

Psa 119:25 **Daleth.** My soul clings to the dust; give me life according to your word!

Psa 119:26 When I told of my ways, you answered me; teach me your statutes!

Psa 119:27 Make me understand the way of your precepts, and I will meditate on your wondrous works.

Psa 119:28 My soul melts away for sorrow; strengthen me according to your word!

Psa 119:29 Put false ways far from me and graciously teach me your law!

Psa 119:30 I have chosen the way of faithfulness; I set your rules before me.

Psa 119:31 I cling to your testimonies, O LORD; let me not be put to shame!

The theme for this section of Psalm 119:25-32 is the desire to cleave closely (dabaq) to God’s path (derek), to stay on the road that leads to him and the sorrow (dalaph) that comes when we leave that path. .

His Word Revives Us

In submitting ourselves in dependence to God, He will revive us by His promises and lead us to declare His mercy to others. JFB

“Revive me according to Your Word

Only His Word can revive us when depression, defeat, discouragement, despair and desperation.

Strong's #2421 – Revive – “Chayah”

To live, to exist, to enjoy life, to live anew to recover, to be well, to make alive, to enliven, to animate, to quicken, to preserve, to refresh, to rebuild, to restore to life.

Deut. 30:15-20 Life is completely related to the Word of God.

Deu 30:15 "See, I have set before you today life and good, death and evil.

Deu 30:16 If you obey the commandments of the LORD your God that I command you today, by loving the LORD your God, by walking in his ways, and by keeping his commandments and his statutes and his rules, then you shall live and multiply, and the LORD your God will bless you in the land that you are entering to take possession of it.

Deu 30:17 But if your heart turns away, and you will not hear, but are drawn away to worship other gods and serve them,

Deu 30:18 I declare to you today, that you shall surely perish. You shall not live long in the land that you are going over the Jordan to enter and possess.

Deu 30:19 I call heaven and earth to witness against you today, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and curse. Therefore choose life, that you and your offspring may live,

Deu 30:20 loving the LORD your God, obeying his voice and holding fast to him, for he is your life and length of days, that you may dwell in the land that the LORD swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them."

As Yeshua points out. We gain our very life from Gods Word and not only by physical bread but by spiritual bread.

Mat 4:4 But he answered, "It is written, "'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.'"

Deu 8:3 And he humbled you and let you hunger and fed you with manna, which you did not know, nor did your fathers know, that he might make you know that man does not live by bread

alone, but man lives by every word that comes from the mouth of the LORD.

harm so that it might not bring me pain!" And God granted what he asked.

What are you letting in your ‘Door’? The mouth is the doorway to the Heart (Spirit and Soul)

Psalms 141:3 Set a guard, O LORD, over my mouth; keep watch over the door of my lips!

Psalms 141:4 Do not let my heart incline to any evil, to busy myself with wicked deeds in company with men who work iniquity, and let me not eat of their delicacies!

Psalms 141:5 Let a righteous man strike me—it is a kindness; let him rebuke me—it is oil for my head; let my head not refuse it. Yet my prayer is continually against their evil deeds.

Have you entered into the door of life?

John 10:9 I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture.

Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me.

Psalms 119:32 – “I run the way of your commands, for you enlarge my heart”

Enlarge – Hebrew/Rachab- A primitive root to broaden, to enlarge (make large) make room, make wide.

We need to cry out to God to enlarge our borders, to enlarge our hearts to receive more of His wisdom, knowledge and truth within us. Do we cry out for more of Him, do we cry out to keep us on the path of righteousness.

2Samuel 22:37 You gave a wide place for my steps under me, and my feet did not slip;

1Chronicles 4:10 Jabez called upon the God of Israel, saying, "Oh that you would bless me and enlarge my border, and that your hand might be with me, and that you would keep me from

Ephesians 3:17 so that Messiah may dwell in your hearts through faith. I pray that you, being rooted and grounded in love,

Ephesians 3:18 may have strength to grasp with all the kedoshim what is the width and length and height and depth,

Ephesians 3:19 and to know the love of Messiah which surpasses knowledge, so you may be filled up with all the fullness of God. (TLV)

Hebrew- Heart “lev” – The will, intellect, feelings

Our Heart is not just the muscle that pumps life giving blood into our bodies, but it is also the Spiritual Heart that pumps life giving truth to our spirit man as well when it is filled up with the Word.

Psalms 19:8 the precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes;
