



Value-50= Jubilee

FIFTY

It is the number of jubilee or deliverance. It is the issue of 7 x 7 (72), and points to deliverance and rest following on as the result of the perfect consummation of time Numbers in Scripture

Ancient Symbol – Seed, Sprout – Means Continue, Activity & Life

Perkei Avos- Ethics of the Fathers – “Lamp, Light, Life”

Pro 6:23 For the mitzvah is a lamp, Torah a light, and corrective discipline the way of life, TLV

Pro 13:9 The light of the righteous shines brightly. The lamp of the wicked is snuffed out. TLV

The above verses contains a thumbnail description of the three parts of the Torah (Gods Teaching and Instructions).

Mitzvah- the physical performance of the commandments, is like a lamp. It is a receptacle that contains oil & wick- or electricity and filament provides light. So too, one uses hands to affix a

Psa 119:109 I hold my life in my hand continually, but I do not forget your law.


Psa 119:110 The wicked have laid a snare for me, but I do not stray from your precepts.

mezuzah, feet to rush to the synagogue, wealth to contribute to charity. Like a lamp that uses physical items to provide and sustain life, the body, the world combine to do God's will in a tangible way. But once the oil is consumed and the wick is spent, the lamp is still and dark. Its light is never more than temporary. Even the longest lasting fluorescent bulb will burn out eventually. And the glow of mitzvah fades away.

The Torah however, is different in a basic way. Its light is spiritual. It unites its students with the source of all wisdom. Just as His wisdom is timeless, so the Torah is timeless and its spiritual capital permanent.

The Third component of our faith the way of life is the remonstrance of reproof. "Reproof is unpleasant, especially for people foolish enough to resent criticism. But intelligent people welcome it, relish it, thrive on it.

BDB Definition:

1) lamp

The eightfold *Nun*. The word of God is his constant guide, to which he has entrusted himself for ever. The way here below is a way through darkness, and leads close past abysses: in this danger of falling and of going astray the word of God is a lamp to his feet, i.e., to his course, and a light to his path (Pro 6:23); his lamp or torch and his sun. That which he has sworn, viz., to keep God's righteous requirements, he has also set up, i.e., brought to fulfilment, but not without being bowed down under heavy afflictions in confessing God; wherefore he prays (as in Psa 119:25) that God would revive him

in accordance with His word, which promises life to those who keep it.

The confessions of prayer coming from the inmost impulse of his whole heart, in which he owns his indebtedness and gives himself up entirely to God's mercy, he calls the free-will offerings of his mouth in Psa 119:108 (cf. Psa 50:14; 19:15). He bases the prayer for a gracious acceptance of these upon the fact of his being reduced to extremity. "To have one's soul in one's hand" is the same as to be in conscious peril of one's life, just as "to take one's soul into one's hand" (Jdg 12:3; 1Sa 19:5; 1Sa 28:21; Job 13:14) is the same as to be ready to give one's life for it, to risk one's life. Mat 25:8 Now the foolish ones said to the wise, 'Give us some of your oil, since our lamps are going out.'


Mat 25:9 But the wise ones replied, ‘No, there won’t be enough for us and for you. Instead, go to those who sell, and buy some for yourselves.’
