

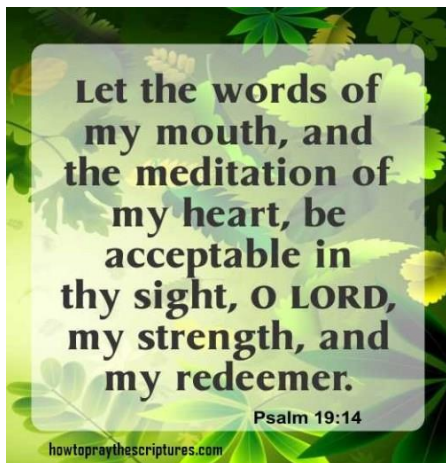

The Mouth and Heart Connection



Psa 119:129 **Pe.** Your testimonies are wonderful; therefore my soul keeps them.

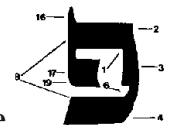

The letter PEH is equivalent to the number eighty in the Hebrew alphabet. It appears in two forms, bent and elongated. The elongated form of PEH is only used as the final letter of a word.

The letter PEH means 'mouth' in Hebrew. As symbolic of a mouth, the PEH represents the differentiating factor between humans and animals: the capacity for speech and self-expression.

The letter PEH, being the seventeenth letter of the Hebrew alphabet, equals the word tov (numerically calculated to mean 'good')

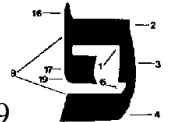

Peh- the Symbol The Peh In Psalm 119 of Speech and Silence

The Peh stands for mouth, the organ of speech. When God created man, He blew into his nostrils the soul of life, and man became a living being. Genesis 2:7-Onkelos interprets the phrase “living being” as a speaking spirit. As Rashi comments, it is man’s power of intelligent speech that best differentiates between animal and human.

In Halacha, too, thought alone is often not sufficient, but requires verbalization. This concept is called “words in the heart are not words”. Anything that happens, whether spiritual, emotional or physical can be transformed into action only after it finds expression in words whether or not they are verbalized.

Consistency of Mouth and Heart

The utterance of the mouth must be in consonance with the feelings of the heart. At times the mouth expresses loyalty to God, while the heart does not truly mean it. This happened at Sinai, where the Jewish people proclaimed “We will do and we will listen” but shortly thereafter they worshiped the Golden Calf. Although their declaration of loyalty represented the zenith in Israel’s national

attainment, it could not have been totally sincere or they would have not fallen so low so soon after. This is not to diminish Israel's greatness at Sinai; it is merely to lament that after going so far, they did not go even further.

At times, the heart trusts strongly in God, yet the mouth denies the belief of the heart. Such was the case in Babylon, where in their hearts the Children of Israel were loyal to YHWH, but out of fear of Nebucahdnezzar, declared allegiance to him with their mouths. Concerning this YHWH said "Let the mouth that was at Sinai (and was spurred by enthusiasm) atone for the mouth that was in Bablyon (and spoke unfaithfully) and let the (faithful) heart that was in Bablyon atone for the (wavering) heart at Sinai/ Eicha Rabbasi 3:20

The Midrash poetically compares significant characteristics of speech to the ocean:

Words, like the ocean, can be stormy or calm
An evil mouth, like turbulent waves, can destroy and kill

A sharp tongue, like deep water, is feared
Good words, like pearls on the ocean floor, are precious

The mouth, like the oceans and rivers which join in the praise of their Creator (Psalms 148:7) was given to all men to express song and praise for Him, who created the world and all within it

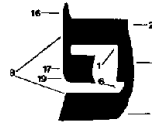
Psa 119:130 The entrance of your words gives light. It gives understanding to the simple.

Psa 119:131 I opened my mouth wide and panted, for I longed for your mitzvot.

Literally "opening" here means the entering of God's words into the heart.

Are we speaking Words of Faith? Do are actions show we are a people who believe God by our actions?

There must be an outworking of that inner(heart) conviction- James 2:18, 20, 24

Unbelief is SIN- John 16:9, Romans 14:23, Hebrews 3:12

Faith must be tried, to be proven true-Psalms 18:30, 105:19, James 1:3-4, 1 Peter 1:6-7

It can be disturbed and lost through doubt, unbelief and wrong speaking!

The Word of God-John 4:39-42, 8:30, Acts 4:4, Romans 10:17

The Written Word-John 20:31, Acts 17:11-12

Prayer-Mark 9:24-Luke 22:32
